

FAIRPLAY BEACH AND RESERVOIR

Maximum stay is four (4) nights.

Tent camping only, no RVs.

No motorized vehicles in camping area, wheelchairs accepted.

Camping permits are issued on a first-come basis, for the ten (10) campsites.

Cooking is allowed on gas fueled camp stoves or grills, no campfires or grills allowed.

Please do not wash dishes, utensils, clothing or other property in the river or reservoir.

Each campsite shall be occupied by no more than two (2) tents and/or six (6) people.

No noise after 9:00pm. Lights out at 11:00pm, flash lights accepted.

Small generators are permitted between 9:00am and 9:00pm.

All trash must be picked up and removed from campsite. Waste receptacles are available in the parking area, for camping trash only, please no household trash.

Pets must be leashed and under control at all times. Pet waste must be removed from Beach and Reservoir area.

Issuance of a camping permit does not include fishing or gold panning. It is the responsibility of the person engaging in these activities to ensure that required license and permits are obtained. Alcohol is prohibited.

Boats and/or other floatation devices are prohibited. No swimming or wading. Wading is allowed while fishing.

We hope that you enjoy your stay in Fairplay. Please help us to preserve the natural beauty of our beach and reservoir.
