The Town of Fairplay's regular municipal election was held on April 3, 2018. Final results include a total of 150 votes cast - 35% voter turnout based on 429 registered voters in Fairplay. Elected to the Town Board of Trustees serving four-year terms are Ray Douglas and Eve Stapp. Elected to serve a four-year term as the Mayor of Fairplay is Frank Just.
