

## Summit Stage to Begin Park County Commuter Route on April 21<sup>st</sup>!

- On April 21<sup>st</sup> a new bus route from Fairplay to Breckenridge will begin.
- The route will include two morning trips to Breckenridge and two afternoon return trips to Fairplay.
- Morning departures will be from both the old CDOT Bus Barn at 850 Hathaway at 6:40am and 7:40am and at 4<sup>th</sup> and Main at 6:45am and 7:45 am with the return trip leaving Breckenridge at 5:15pm and 6:15pm.
- The cost of this route will be \$2.00 cash fare (one way).
- Disabled persons, elderly persons and students will pay a \$1.00 cash fare (one way).
- 10-ride punch passes will be available from the drivers for \$20.00.
- Exact change is required.
