- **Are you interested in serving on the Fairplay Town Board?** - Nomination Petitions will be available beginning on Tuesday, January 7, 2020 for the April 7, 2020 Town of Fairplay Election. The Town has three Trustee positions up for election. Those seats are currently held by Paul Kemp, Cindy Bear and Scott Dodge. Nomination petitions will be available at Town Hall and can be circulated January 7, 2020 through January 27, 2020. All petitions are due back into Town Hall by 4:30 p.m. on January 27, 2020. To be eligible for office you must be a registered elector and have resided in the Town limits for at least 12 consecutive months immediately prior to the date of the election (April 7, 2020). - **Vendor Applications Available** — Vendor applications are available for Burro Days, July 24-26. Go to our website for more information, burrodays.com or call 719-836-2622, ext. 109. You may also stop by Town Hall at 901 Main Street to pick up an application.
- **Business Licenses** – The Town of Fairplay business licenses are now due for renewal. All businesses or individuals engaged in any activity with the object of financial gain are required to have a Town business license. If you are doing business in Fairplay, please renew your license right away. If you have questions please contact us by phone (719) 836-2622, or stop in at Town Hall, 901 Main Street. Business license applications can also be found on the Town's website, fairplayco.us, go to documents & forms.
- **Dog License Required** – All dogs over six months of age within the Town limits of Fairplay must be licensed. Any dog that has been spayed or neutered is \$5. Any dog, male or female, that has not been spayed or neutered is \$10. Licenses must be renewed each year. Come by Town Hall for the appropriate paperwork, 901 Main Street. You must bring your current vaccination records from your veterinarian with you. Please remember to clean up after your dogs as you walk them through Town.
- **Livestock Permits** – The Town of Fairplay requires anyone keeping animals or fowl within the corporate limits of the Town to have a valid livestock permit. No animal or fowl shall be allowed to run or fly at large. Please go to our website, www.fairplayco.us, under documents and forms or come to Town Hall for a livestock permit, 901 Main Street.
